

Pre-K Curriculum Overview

Bible

Striving to engage students in a love for the Lord is the very heart of our program. Through daily Bible lessons, the aim will be to instill important biblical truths in the hearts of our students. Bible lessons will highlight major stories from Old and New Testaments. In addition, students will memorize verses related to themes we study. Hymns and catechism will also be included.

Language/Reading

Daily language and reading activities will be aimed at helping our students to master important skills necessary to become proficient readers and communicators. Daily read-aloud stories and poems from classic children's literature will be integrated into the curriculum. Students will be introduced to all 26 letters and letter sounds.

Math

Daily math centers, games, and activities will introduce basic math concepts such as graphing, sorting, one-to-one correspondence, counting, and identifying shapes.
